



2019 Golf Course Aeration Schedule

April 15th – 30th:

- Aeration of Tees, Fairways, Driving Range Tees, and Target Greens – 1/2” Hollow Tines on Tees No Sand, 3/4” Solid Tines on Fairways, and Target Greens – Healing Time 2 Weeks

May 14th:

- Dry-Ject Aeration 10 days Healing Time – Rain Date would be Wednesday the 15th

June 13th – 14th:

- Needle Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days
- Needle Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days

July 16th – 17th:

- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days
- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days

August 16th – 17th:

- Needle Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days
- Needle Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days

September 1st – 15th:

- Aeration of Tees, Fairways, Driving Range Tees, and Target Greens – 1/2” Hollow Tines on Tees, 3/4 Solid Tines on Fairways, and Target Greens – Healing Time 2 Weeks

September 17th and 18th:

- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days
- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days
