

2020 Golf Course Aeration Schedule

April 20th- May 1st:

- Aeration of Course Tees, and Driving Range Tees – 1/2” Hollow Tines No Sand
3/4” Solid Tines on Fairways, and Driving Range Target Greens – Healing Time 2 Weeks for all areas

May 1st:

- Turn on Irrigation for the Season:

May 12th and May 13th will be the rain date if needed:

- Dry-Ject Aeration with Contractor 10 days Healing Time

June 8th and 9th:

- Needle Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days
- Needle Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days

July 6th and 7th:

- Needle Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days
- Needle Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green - No Sanding or Disruption to Play - Healing Time 7 Days

July 27th and 28th:

- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens on the 27th - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days
- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Back 9 Greens and Nursery Green on the 28th - No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days

August 10th thru 21st:

- Aeration of Tees, and Driving Range Tees – 3/8” Hollow Tines No Sand. 1/2” Solid Tines on Fairways, and Driving Range Target Greens – Healing Time 2 Weeks for all areas

September 7th and 8th:

- 3/8” Hollow Tine Aeration of Front 9 Greens and Putting Greens on the 7th, and Back 9 and Nursery on the 8th- No Sanding and Minimal Disruption to Play - Healing Time 10 Days

September 30th:

- Irrigation will be shut off for the season and we will begin winterizing the system
